The contribution will assist these Parties to actively participate in the discussions at OEWG-8 and make their input. - There will be opportunities at the COP for the developed and donor countries to discuss implementation issues with the participants from the developing countries and countries with economies in transition.
- Participants will be able to participate in side-events.
